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<p>Gender Masculine/Feminine gatto/gatta (cat)</p> <p>Number Singular/Plural gatti/gatte (cats)</p> <p>Articles Articles can be definite or indefinite, it depends if they refer to a known object or not and they can help you identify the gender and number of the nouns they refer to, as they change depending on that.</p> <p>Adjectives Italian adjectives agree in gender (masculine/feminine) and number (singular/plural) with the nouns they modify.</p> <p>Personal Pronouns Personal pronouns are pronouns that are associated primarily with a particular grammatical person – first person, second person, or third person.
