What should I already know?

- How to greet and introduce yourself and others in Italian.
Count to 20.
Talk about things you like and dislike.
Name the days of the week, the months of the year and the seasons.

Listening - I will be able to understand a few familiar spoken words and phrases - e.g. what the weather is like, name of nationalities looking at pictures of different flags. Di dove sei?
Speaking - I will be able to say and repeat single words and short simple phrases. e.g. naming animals, listening to the name of food items looking at pictures of food.
Reading - I will be able to match the pictures of stories ("Il Serpent Sam", "I tre porcellini" with words and repeat words and sentences.
Writing - I will be able to attempt to write taught vocabulary (single words) from memory.
