Sometimes when you sign up to a website or game it asks you to put your name and a picture of yourself.</p> <p>To keep yourself safe you should use a screen name (which is not your real name) and an avatar – which is like a cartoon picture of yourself.</p> <div><div><p>Flowergirl123</p></div><div><p>Footballboy11</p></div></div> <p>What is cyber-bullying?</p> <p>Cyber bullying is any form of bullying which takes place online or through smartphones and tablets. The internet can be a fun place to play games and talk with your friends, but what do you do when things go wrong?</p> <p>Remember, even if you can't see someone, the things you say or write online can still upset them.
