Pupils should be taught:

To recognise safe and unsafe situations and ways of keeping safe, including simple rules for keeping safe online To use simple rules for resisting pressure when they feel unsafe or uncomfortable

Identifying and correctly name their "private parts" (see NSPCC resource PANTS) for the purposes of safeguarding them from sexual exploitation

Importance of seeking and giving permission in relationships.
